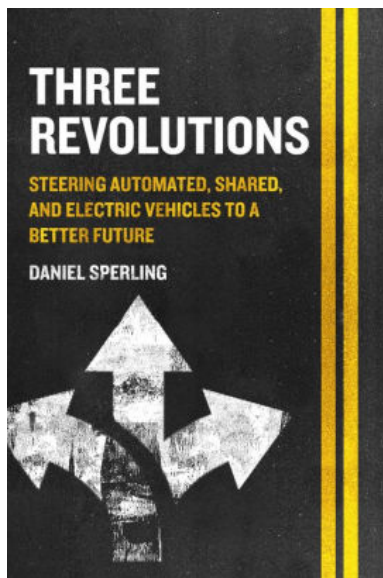


## Books for Those Who Seek
